

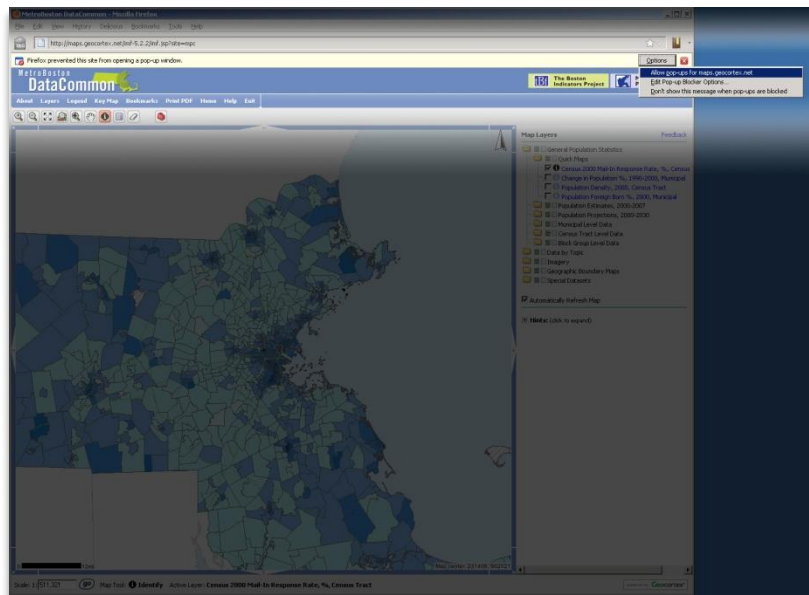

Allow MetroBoston DataCommon Pop-Up Windows

Certain functions, such as viewing attribute information in the DataMap tool, require pop-up windows. Depending on your browser setting, pop-up blockers might limit this functionality. However, you can adjust the settings to allow pop-up windows for the web site address www.metrobostondatacommon.org and maps.geocortex.net, where the maps are created.

Mozilla Firefox

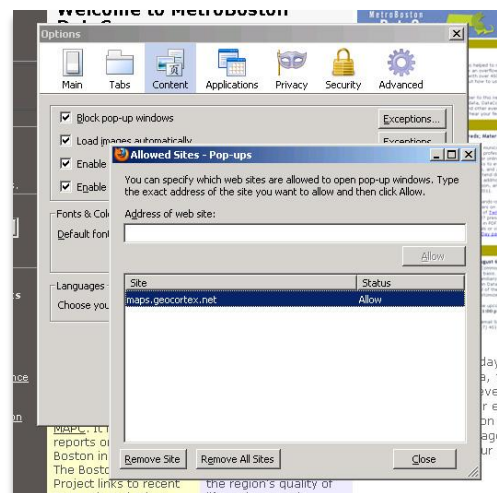
If Firefox’s pop-up blocker is enabled (usually by default), then the browser will notify you that **Firefox prevented this site from opening a pop-up window** by showing a yellow bar above the web site’s content.



Clicking the **option**-button drops down a short menu where you choose to allow pop-ups for maps.geocortex.net.

Alternatively, you can review and modify allowed pop-up domains by going to the **Tools menu** in the top menu bar and calling the **options panel** there.

In the **content** section you can either globally check or uncheck the option to Block pop-up windows. The button **Exceptions...** opens a list of all allowed web sites - maps.geocortex.net will show up there if you allowed that web site address in the previous step. You can also manually add addresses by typing them into the blank text field and clicking the button **Allow**.



Selecting a web site address and clicking the button **Remove Site** in the lower part of the window, removes that web site address from the list of allowed addresses.

Microsoft Internet Explorer

If Internet Explorer's pop-up blocker is enabled, (usually by default), then the browser will show **Pop-up blocked** in a yellow bar above the web site's content.

Clicking the **yellow bar** drops down a short menu where you choose to **Always allow Pop-ups from this site...**

Another option is it go to **Tools > Pop-up Blocker**, where you can manually choose to block pop-ups for the current site, to turn the pop-up blocker off entirely or to open more Pop-up Blocker Settings.

In the **Pop-up Blocker Settings** window all blocked web site addresses are shown and you can add to or remove sites from the pop-up blocker list.
